TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR BIDDERS:

- 1) All items are sold As-Is, Where is with no warranties written or implied. Bidders are encouraged to inspect items personally before placing bids! No refunds, no returns, no adjustments.
- 2) All successful bids must be paid in full by the end of the auction.
- 3) Payments made online are subject to an Internet Bidding Fee of 3%, added to high bid price. Additionally payments made by credit card in person are subject to a Service Fee of 3%.
- 4) Applicable sales tax will be charged unless proper exemption documentation provided with payment.
- 5) The purchaser assumes responsibility for all purchased items as soon as the bid is struck down by the auctioneer.
- 6) All purchases must be removed from the premises no later than February 26th at 3:30 PM. Any items left on the premises after this deadline will be discarded with no refunds issued. The Holtz-Her CNC machine and any tables or racking will have an extended removal period (see special removal terms below).
- 7) No assistance will be provided for loading and removal of auction items. Any rigging or loading will be the sole responsibility of the purchaser.
- 8) All online bidders will need to register online and wait for approval from the auctioneer before they will be allowed to place bids. Online bidders are required to register before February 22, 2010 at 10am.

SPECIAL REMOVAL TERMS:

Lot #50 (Holtz-Her CNC Machine & Accessories) will have an extended removal deadline of 3:30 PM on March 3rd, due to the size and weight of the machinery.

Any tables and shelving cannot be removed until March 3rd, because many are in use to showcase the other auction merchandise.

Containers cannot be removed until 10 days after the auction (by appointment only).
